Memory Card Game

You need:

- ❖ 2 copies of the Lily card pictures
- ❖ Construction paper
- ❖ Glue
- ❖ Scissors

Make the Cards:

- ❖ Print 2 copies of the Lily card pictures
- ❖ Glue sheets onto construction paper
- ❖ Cut out each card

You will end up with 12 pairs of matching cards, for a total of 24 cards.



How to play (for two or more players):

- ❖ Lay your cards face down and mix them up. Don't peek!
- ❖ Youngest player starts
- ❖ Turn over two cards. If they match, the player keeps the pair, if not, turn them face down again.
- ❖ Next player takes a turn.
- ❖ Each player takes turns until all the cards are matched.
- ❖ Player with the most matches wins.
